HELLO, I'm happy to be here! I am Fr. Don Dusza, originally from Vintondale and graduate from Bishop Carroll in 1973, Penn State in 1977 with a degree in Environmental Resource Management. God said no, you're going into the seminary; St. Pius X in Kentucky, Mt. St. Mary's in Maryland and was ordained in 1983 for Altoona-Johnstown Diocese. My first assignment was St. Francis Xavier, Cresson 1983-85. I went into the Air Force as a Chaplain to San Bernardino CA, Keflavik Iceland, Patrick AFB Florida, Misawa Japan and Cheyenne Wyoming. In 1991, I returned to the diocese at St. Mary's Altoona, Cathedral Altoona, St. Patrick, Johnstown, Our Mother of Sorrows & St. Michael Brownstown, SS. Phillip & James Meyersdale and St. Gregory MacDonaldton, St. Casimir Johnstown, St. Thomas Bedford, St. Joseph Renovo, and Prince of Peace Northern Cambria. In 2019, I was accused of something in 1985 (which didn't happen) so for the past 6 1/2 years, I was not publicly allowed to say Mass. In November, I received word from Rome that I've been cleared, and I'm looking forward to being a priest again!
